



Fitting Instructions: Sprint ST 1050 from VIN 440391 and Sprint GT 1050 A9708231

Thank you for choosing this Triumph genuine accessory kit. This accessory kit is the product of Triumph's use of proven engineering, exhaustive testing, and continuous striving for superior reliability, safety and performance.

Completely read all of these instructions before commencing the installation of the accessory kit in order to become thoroughly familiar with the kit's features and the installation process.

These instructions should be considered a permanent part of your accessory kit, and should remain with it even if your accessory equipped motorcycle is subsequently sold.

Parts Supplied:

1. High 'screen	1 off	3. Gasket strip, right hand	1 off
2. Gasket strip, left hand	1 off	4. Cleaning wipe	1 off



Warning

This accessory kit is designed for use on Triumph Sprint ST 1050 from VIN 440391 and Sprint GT 1050 motorcycles only and should not be fitted to any other Triumph model or to any other manufacturer's motorcycle. Fitting this accessory kit to any other Triumph model, or to any other manufacturer's motorcycle, may interfere with the rider and could affect the handling, stability or other aspects of the motorcycle's operation which may result in loss of motorcycle control and an accident.



Warning

Always have Triumph approved parts, accessories and conversions fitted by a trained technician of an authorised Triumph dealer. The fitment of parts, accessories and conversions by a technician who is not of an authorised Triumph dealer may affect the handling, stability or other aspects of the motorcycle's operation which may result in loss of motorcycle control and an accident.



Warning

Throughout this operation, ensure that the motorcycle is stabilised and adequately supported on a paddock stand to prevent risk of injury from the motorcycle falling.



Warning


A torque wrench of known accurate calibration must be used when fitting this accessory kit. Failure to tighten any of the fasteners to the correct torque may affect motorcycle performance, handling and stability. This may result in loss of motorcycle control and an accident.

1. Position the motorcycle on a paddock stand.
2. Remove the original 'screen as described in the service manual. Retain the 'screen if the motorcycle is returned to its original condition. Retain the fixings for re-use.

Note:


- **Read the warning notices printed on the cleaning wipe packet in the fitting kit.**
- 3. Clean the underside edges of the high 'screen with the cleaning wipe supplied in the kit.

4. Peel off the backing strip from the self-adhesive gaskets. Align the gaskets to the underside of the 'screen as shown below. Ensure the holes in the gaskets line up with the holes in the 'screen.

2. Right hand gasket
3. Left hand gasket

5. Position the 'screen to the cockpit fairing. Fit the original fixings and tighten to **3 Nm**.

6. Remove the paddock stand.



Warning

After fitting the high 'screen kit the motorcycle will exhibit new handling characteristics. Operate the motorcycle in a safe area free from traffic to gain familiarity with any new characteristics. Operation of the motorcycle when not familiar with any new handling characteristics may result in loss of motorcycle control and an accident.



Warning

Never ride an accessory equipped motorcycle (including those fitted with Triumph approved windscreens and luggage systems) at speeds above 80 mph (130 km/h).

The presence of accessories such as windscreens and luggage systems will cause changes in the stability and handling of the motorcycle. Failure to allow for changes in motorcycle stability may lead to loss of control or an accident.

Remember that the 80 mph (130 km/h) limit will be reduced by the fitting of non-approved accessories, incorrect loading, worn tyres, overall motorcycle condition and poor road or weather conditions.



Warning

Only operate this Triumph motorcycle at high speed in closed-course on road competition or on closed-course racetracks. High speed operation should only be attempted by riders who have been instructed in the techniques necessary for high speed riding and are familiar with the motorcycle's characteristics in all conditions.

High speed operation in any other circumstances is dangerous and will lead to loss of motorcycle control and an accident.



Warning

Never attempt to clean or adjust the high 'screen while riding the motorcycle. Removal of the rider's hands from the handlebars while riding the motorcycle will diminish the ability of the rider to maintain control of the motorcycle. Attempting to clean or adjust the high 'screen while riding the motorcycle may result in loss of control of the motorcycle and an accident.



Warning

The high 'screen is not a substitute for a helmet or eye protection. Sports 'screens are designed to provide wind protection and increased riding comfort. They are not designed to provide protection in the event of a collision with another vehicle, the road, birds or any other object. When riding a motorcycle both rider and passenger must always wear a crash helmet, eye protection, gloves and trousers (close fitting around the knees and ankle). Although full protection is not possible, wearing correct protective clothing can reduce the risk of injury when riding.



Warning

If after fitment of this accessory kit, you have any doubt about the performance of any aspect of the motorcycle, contact an authorised Triumph dealer and do not ride the motorcycle until the authorised dealer has declared it fit for use. Riding a motorcycle when there is any doubt as to any aspect of the performance of the motorcycle may result in loss of control of the motorcycle leading to an accident.
